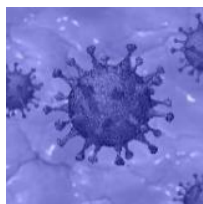

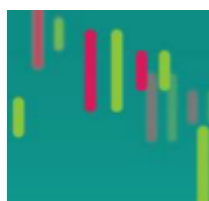


Dr Calvin Ho on Ethics and COVID-19 in East Asia
