Editorial:



Doctor's conviction of Gross Negligence Manslaughter in Hong Kong and CMEL's forthcoming webinar on this topic

On 1st December 2020, Dr MAK Wan Ling, a registered medical practitioner, was found guilty of Manslaughter by Gross Negligence in a retrial by the High Court in Hong Kong. Dr Mak administered a heavily contaminated processed blood product to a patient, causing the patient's death. Dr Mak failed to ensure that bacteria tests had been conducted on the blood product and to obtain proper consent from the deceased.

To follow up, CMEL will hold a webinar to explore some of the issues raised such as:

- the test for determining whether the defendant's conduct involved "gross negligence"; and
- the arguments for and against prosecuting medical doctors for "Gross Negligence Manslaughter".

2020年12月1日,註冊醫生麥允齡在香港高等法院重審中,被裁定「嚴重疏忽導致誤殺」罪名成立。麥醫生向一名病人施用被嚴重污染的血液製品,導致病人死亡。麥醫生未曾確保該血液製品已經驗菌測試,並且未有取得病人的正當同意。

本中心將舉辦網上研討會探討此案的相關爭議,例如:

- 以何準則判斷被告的行為是否涉及「嚴重疏忽」;及
- 應否控告醫生「嚴重疏忽導致誤殺」的正反論點。

Ombudsman found Hong Kong government's monitoring mechanism for high-demand vaccines inadequate

In 2019, a number of medical centres allegedly provided counterfeit nine-valent human papillomavirus (HPV) vaccines in Hong Kong. The Office of the Ombudsman has recently completed a direct investigation on the Government's mechanism for monitoring vaccines offered by private healthcare facilities. The investigation has revealed inadequacies in the Government's monitoring mechanism for "vaccines with excessive demands". Read more here.
